Scholarship Amount: 1 @ \$500

Criteria for awarding this scholarship:

- The recipient must be a student and a graduate of USD #395, by the end of the school year, in which the scholarship is awarded.
- The recipient must have a cumulative high school grade point average of at least 3.0.
- The recipient will be selected on the basis of career vision and goals, leadership and community involvement, and financial need.
- Top priority will be given to the recipient that would like to pursue a teaching degree in the field of elementary education followed by secondary education. Studies need to be completed at a four-year college as a full-time student.
- Two letters of recommendation need to be enclosed. It is recommended that one letter be written by a high school teacher or a professional you have worked for or who knows your work ethic. Letters from family members or relatives will not be accepted.

Application Process: Submit completed application to the LHS Counselor, who in turn will submit all applications to Patricia Petz (or her family).

Application Deadline: On or before April 5.

Payment: Recipient must notify Mrs. Petz the address of the college that you are attending, where the financial aid needs to be sent, along with your student ID number in order for the funds to be processed correctly. As soon as this is received, funds will be transferred to the college and a notification letter will be sent to the recipient.

Notification: The LHS Counselor will inform the recipient of selection. <u>A thank</u> you letter from the recipient is desired.
