Fee Waivers

Fee waivers cover the basic registration fees and provide free access to The Official ACT® Self-Paced Course, Powered by Kaplan® and your ACT My Answer Key on select test dates. Check with your school counselor to see if you are eligible to apply. Qualified students can request up to four fee waivers for the ACT test from their counselor.

Students who have taken the ACT with a fee waiver can send an unlimited number of score reports for free including their ACT Superscore or scores from any individual test, even those taken previously during the ACT National Test and State and District Testing.

The ACT® Test Is Evolving

Starting in April 2025, students who choose to test online will have more flexibility and choice, experience a shorter test, and get more time to respond to each question. Here's a summary of what's changing:



Demonstrating your writing skills and ability to understand and explore ideas can help you stand out for competitive programs.

The ACT shows the range of your knowledge

The four sections of the ACT test — English, math, r<mark>eadi</mark>ng, and science — each make up 25% of the test and 25% of your score, providing a broad and balanced view of your abilities. Other tests have just two sections, with Math and Reading each being 50% of your score.



The ACT can help save money on tuition

Your ACT score can increase your chances of earning scholarships that can fuel your future and help with college costs. Even schools that are test optional may still require or recommend an ACT score to qualify for merit awards.

Only the ACT offers support for English Language learners

If you are enrolled in your school's English Learners (EL) program, you may qualify for additional support when taking the ACT. Work with your school counselor to request EL accommodations after you register.


The ACT offers fee waivers for eligible students




